Registration Policy: Registration is on a first come, first served basis open to boys & girls ages 3* to 13

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: To weeks prior to start of camp session. Pre-registration and payment in full by due date required to guarantee participation. *Children must be potty trained.

Financial Terms: Non-refundable 50% deposit must accompany this application to secure placement. Camp fee balance is due minimum of two weeks prior to start of camp session.

Refund policy: No refunds will be made at any time after camp begins. There is no reduction of fees for late arrival or early departure.

Pick-up/drop-off policy: Drop off no earlier than 15 minutes prior to camp start time. Pick up no later than camp ending time. \$10.00 late pick up fee for each additional 15 minutes will be charged for campers who are picked up later than the camp ending time and is payable upon pickup.

Medical & Insurance Terms: All campers must be covered by their own medical insurance policy.

To ensure your child has a fun, positive and safe experience at Camp OC, please read and refer to the Camp Policies and Procedures.

Registration Policy: Registration is on a first come, first served basis and is open to children ages 3* to 13. Pre-registration and payment in full by due date required to guarantee participation. **Children must be potty trained.*

Financial Terms: **Non-refundable 50% deposit** must accompany this application to secure placement. **Camp fee balance is due minimum of two weeks prior to start of camp session.**

Refund policy: No refunds will be made at any time after camp begins. There is no reduction of fees for late arrival or early departure.

An early drop off option is available for an additional charge at time of registration.

Pick up no later than camp ending time. A \$10.00 late pick up fee for each additional 15 minutes will be charged and is payable upon pick up for campers who are picked up later than the camp ending time.

What to expect:

- ◆ Camp OC offers a variety of exciting activities including Gymnastics, Cheer, Dance and Trampoline, Inflatable Obstacle Courses, Zip-Line, Rock Wall, Arts & Crafts and Games. All activities are offered throughout the course of a camp week and may vary by day; Activities are supervised and instructed by experienced and qualified camp counselors.
- ◆ Campers are divided into groups by age and physical ability.

What to bring each day:
