#### **What to expect:**

- ◆ Camp OC offers a variety of exciting activities including Gymnastics, Cheer, Dance and Trampoline, Inflatable Obstacle Courses, Zip-Line, Rock Wall, Arts & Crafts and Games. All activities are offered throughout the course of a camp week and may vary by day; Activities are supervised and instructed by experienced and qualified camp counselors.
- ◆ Campers are divided into groups by age and physical ability.

#### **What to bring each day:**

##### **A back-pack containing...**

- ◆ A change of clothes in case of accidents (for our younger campers) and arts and crafts spills.
